Non-Profit Spotlight.....


Henry and Pat Potter created L2 for Kids in 2011 with \$14,000 in seed money that initially was raised to start a home for troubled boys. When the State of



Nebraska decided not to use such a home, the money was re-directed into what is now L2 for Kids. L2 for Kids each year helps cloth school age kids with new clothes to wear to school. This program was created so that all children can go to school with new clothes to help their self-esteem and to be just like everyone else. Today, L2 for Kids has councils overseeing 18 Communities. In, 2017 a L2 for Kids, Elwood, Eustis, Farnam council was created with 4 volunteers. Since that day we've helped an average of 15 kids a year.




