## ORDINANCE 2022-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF ELWOOD, GOSPER COUNTY, NEBRASKA APPROVING THE PLAT OF SCHUTZ AG ADMINISTRATIVE SUBDIVISION, AND TO PROVIDE FO THE PUBLICAITON AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ELWOOD, GOSPER COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the plat of SCHUTZ AG ADMINISTRATIVE SUBDIVISION, being part of the South Half (S ½) of Section Seven (7), Township Seven (7) North, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Gosper County, Nebraska, duly made out, acknowledged and certified, is hereby approved, accepted, ratified and authorized to be filed and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Gosper County, Nebraska.
